A Visit to DAV National Headquarters in KY

Members of the USA Cares team recently visited the Disabled American Veterans (DAV) National Headquarters in Erlanger, Kentucky. The visit created an opportunity to connect with another national organization dedicated to supporting veterans and their families, share insights and learn more about how programs across the veteran support network work together.

Each year, DAV provides more than 600,000 rides to medical appointments and assists with over 200,000 veterans benefits claims, while also offering nationwide programs that support caregivers and help veterans access employment opportunities. For USA Cares, the visit reinforced how collaboration across organizations strengthens the overall support system for veterans working toward stability after service.

Each plate costs \$44, with \$10 from every new or renewed registration directly supporting USA Cares programs that provide critical financial assistance and resources that help veterans work toward long term stability.

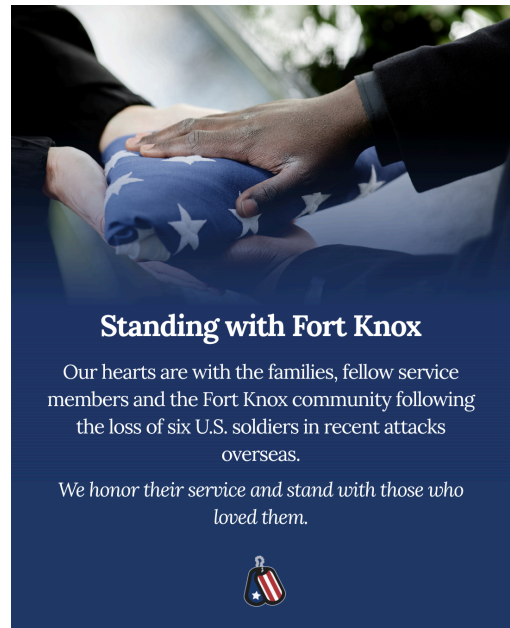


Standing with Fort Knox
